Diana Greene is an active performer, collaborative pianist, organist, and music instructor. Diana is a graduate of Wheaton College where she studied with Reginald Gerig. She also has a Master of Music in Piano Performance from The University of North Texas where she studied with Tong-il Han. Other teachers include Carola Grindea of the London Guildhall School of Music and Mary Sauer of DePaul University and the Chicago Symphony.

Diana served as organist and choir master at All Saints Episcopal Church in Charlotte, North Carolina, and as soprano section leader at St. Peter's Episcopal Church, Charlotte where she was also the accompanist for the Choir School. She studied organ with Gladys Christensen and Dr. Michael Lehtinen and is a member of the American Guild of Organists.

In addition to performing, Diana has taught early childhood music, piano, and choral singing in Texas, North Carolina, Maryland, and New Jersey, and also has arts management experience. She was managing director for *May Music* in Charlotte, North Carolina, and *Chamber Music at St. Peter's* where she performed with members of the Charlotte Symphony. As an early childhood music specialist, Diana holds Level 2 certification from the Early Childhood Music & Movement Association and served as ECMMA president from 2016–2018.
