Blanket Creation Guidelines

- ◆ The Christ Church Blanketeers accept crocheted, knitted, quilted, sewn, fleece, new, and gently used blankets;
- ◆ Blankets should be made using clean, washable, dryable materials, including fabric (woven cotton, flannel, polar fleece), yarn (cotton, or acrylic);
- ◆ Wool, wool yarn, tapestry, burlap, felt, upholstery fabric, double knit, or rug yarn **MUST NOT BE USED**;
- ◆ Before donating a blanket, **CHECK** and **DOUBLE CHECK** that the blanket is free of pins!
- ◆ No buttons, or embellishments that a child could swallow, are allowed;
- ◆ Blankets should not smell or have pet hair on them;
- ◆ Positive messages on blankets are usually acceptable;
- ◆ Sentiments such as "Get Well Soon" or similar sayings are now allowed, since, unfortunately, not everyone will get well.
